Dr Steven Chow is a senior consultant dermatologist at the Pantai Hospital Kuala Lumpur & Gleneagles Intan Medical Centre, Kuala Lumpur and has been in the forefront of advancing dermatology standards and training in the region for the past three decades. He had guided the development of the League of Asean Dermatological Societies(LADS) since 1990 and has been instrumental in the formation of the Asian Academy of Dermatology & Venereology in 2009 as the founder secretary-general. He chaired the AADV/Asian Skin Foundation Committee responsible for the publication of the Asian Consensus in the Management of Chronic Urticaria 2010 and has been the pioneer KOL for use of biologics in psoriasis in Malaysia and the region. He is dedicated to the advancement of regional training and setting of practice benchmarks for clinical dermatology in the region.
